This is a practical, skills-based parenting program that can be applied to every family with children or teens aged between 6 and 16.

It is aimed at helping parents to develop practical and effective ways to enhance their parenting skills and strengthen their children's potential and quality of life. The programme will assist parents in learning skills to encourage positive behaviour, discourage negative behaviour, developing techniques for using effective discipline and teaching their children alternatives to problem behaviour.

The assessment identifies your child's health needs and what health services are needed to meet your child's needs. The assessors do not give a diagnosis.

Meitheal

Meitheal is an early intervention, multi-agency (when necessary) response tailored to the needs of an individual child or young person. If you feel that your child has additional needs, or is facing challenges that are difficult to overcome, and you are finding it hard to access the support necessary to help them, Meitheal may be able to help you. Examples of the challenges that Meitheal could help with are:

- problems at school
- a child feeling down
- not getting on with your child
- family problems
- · coping with illness or bereavement
- difficult behaviour

The kinds of services that might be involved in Meitheal are schools, youth services, family resource centres, medical services and others like these.
